

**More than numbers.** Census data provide unparalleled insight into the world's demographic, social, and economic development. The Argentina 2001 Census, part of the East View Global Census Archive® (GCA), addresses a wide range of topics at the highest level of detail possible.

**Making information available.** When initially acquired, the census data is stored in a complex database structure, with attribute descriptions in Spanish, limiting access to those with significant database management and programming experience. East View simplifies access, formatting the collection into an easy-to-use geodatabase which can be visualized using any GIS software and providing a comprehensive guide. Additionally, East View provides the original census documentation, allowing researchers to see first-hand how the data was gathered.

**Notes**

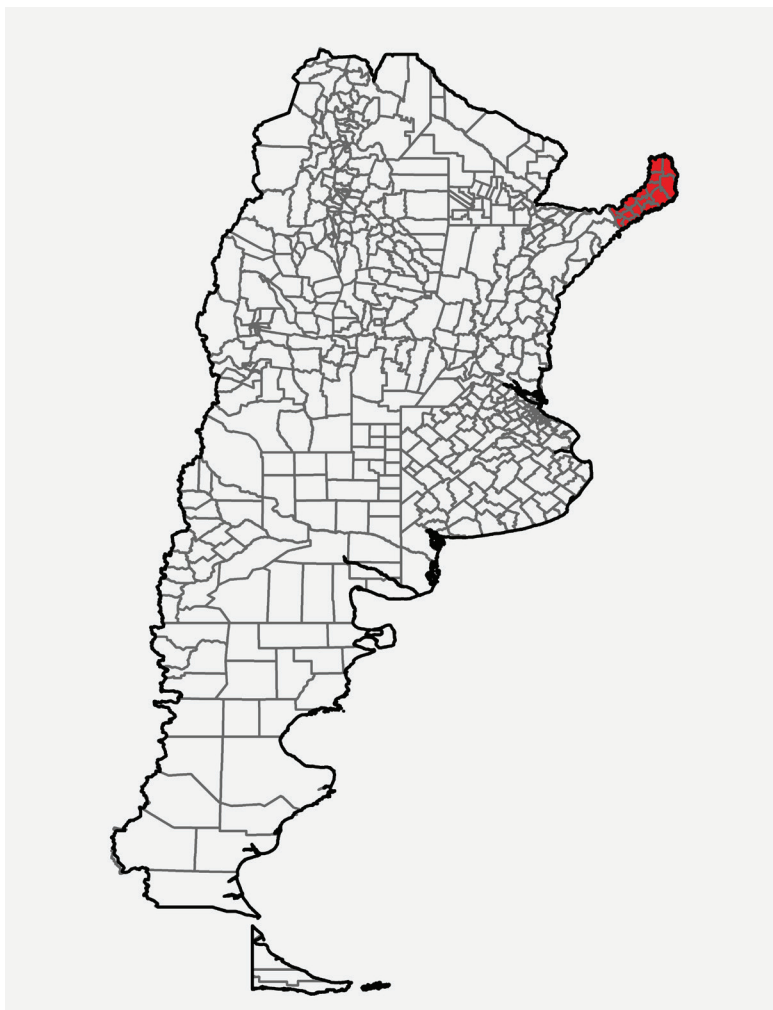
